DIRECTIONS FOR USE

PREPARATION

OF THE BASE The base must be firm, dry, load-bearing, flat and with complete shrinking

processes. Any unsound parts and layers with low mechanical strength must be removed from it beforehand. In areas with large length is required that on every 4-5 m to be cut expansion joints in the base, with width of 1,5 cm which have to

be filled with PU sealant.

WORKING CONDITIONS The screed should be applied in dry weather at temperature of the base and

ambient temperature from +5°C to +30°C and air humidity below 80%.

Do not mix with cement sand or other materials, since this leads to deterioration

of the quality of the screed.

PREPARATION OF THE SOLUTION

In a clean stainless steel container pour about 5L clean water and add

gradually the contents of the bag - 25 kg.

Stir the mixture with an electric mixer until reaching homogeneous mixture

without lumps.

If necessary, water or dry mixture is added to achieve the required density.

Leave to "mature" for about 10 minutes and stir again.

The mixture preserves its density for about 3 hours at temperature 20-25°C.

APPLICATION

The screed is applied no later than 5 min after its preparation. It is drawn up with lute, as for leveling are used leveling guides, placed beforehand. The next layer is applied as soon as possible, after no more than 5-9 minutes. Several layers can be applied until reaching the desired thickness. The finishing layer is smoothed with thrower or other suitable instrument.

CLEANING OF THE

Right after use the tools are cleaned with water. After drying they are

mechanically cleaned.
